Building on the rigorous process it takes to achieve other certifications in PMI's family of credentials, the PgMP® requires two online evaluations:

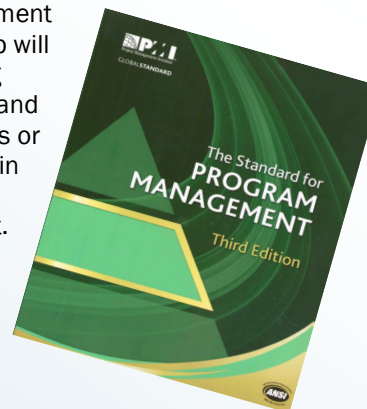
1. An application review by a panel of program managers
